

Hunter Access Program Rules and Regulations

- A permit must be obtained annually from the Bushkill Township Municipal Office to hunt the 632 acres of Township Owned properties enrolled in the Hunter Access Program.
- All applicable Pennsylvania Game Commission hunting laws and regulations must be followed. These laws and regulations can be found at <https://www.pgc.pa.gov/Pages/default.aspx>.
- Permit and provided maps must be on bearer's person while hunting on Bushkill Township's designated Hunter Access Properties.
- Vehicle Parking Pass must be displayed in the windshield of hunter's vehicle.
- Hunting is only permitted on Bushkill Township properties indicated on issued maps.
- All items brought on Bushkill Township Properties are to be taken with you daily when you leave. No trail cameras, treestands, blinds, or other hunting equipment will be left over night, or unattended, for any reason.
- Treestands will be of non-damaging design to the tree and be clearly marked with hunter's CID number.
- Vehicles are **NOT** to be parked along roadways. Vehicles must be parked in designated parking areas marked on issued maps. No Parking outside of designated parking areas. Use parking areas at your own risk.
- The following are strictly prohibited:
 - o Cutting of trees or brush
 - o Damaging of crops
 - o Use of motorized vehicles
- Hunting with firearms (Shotgun, Rifle, Handgun, Muzzleloader, etc.) is strictly prohibited on the following Bushkill Township Preserves:
 - o Ballas Meadow Preserve
 - o Albert Ponds Preserve
 - o Highland Meadows Preserve
- Only species listed on each provided Hunter Access Map may be hunted on that property.
- Handicapped hunting access will be allowed on certain properties. Please contact Bushkill Township Municipal Office if Handicapped Access will be needed.
- All Hunters **MUST** report all harvest totals including "no harvest" to Kerry Reider at the end of the season via email, kreider@bushkilltownship.com or call 610-759-1250. Failure to report harvest will result in a one (1) year suspension from the program.

Violation of Rules and Regulations may result in fine and loss of current and future permits.

Pennsylvania Game Commission will actively patrol all properties.
