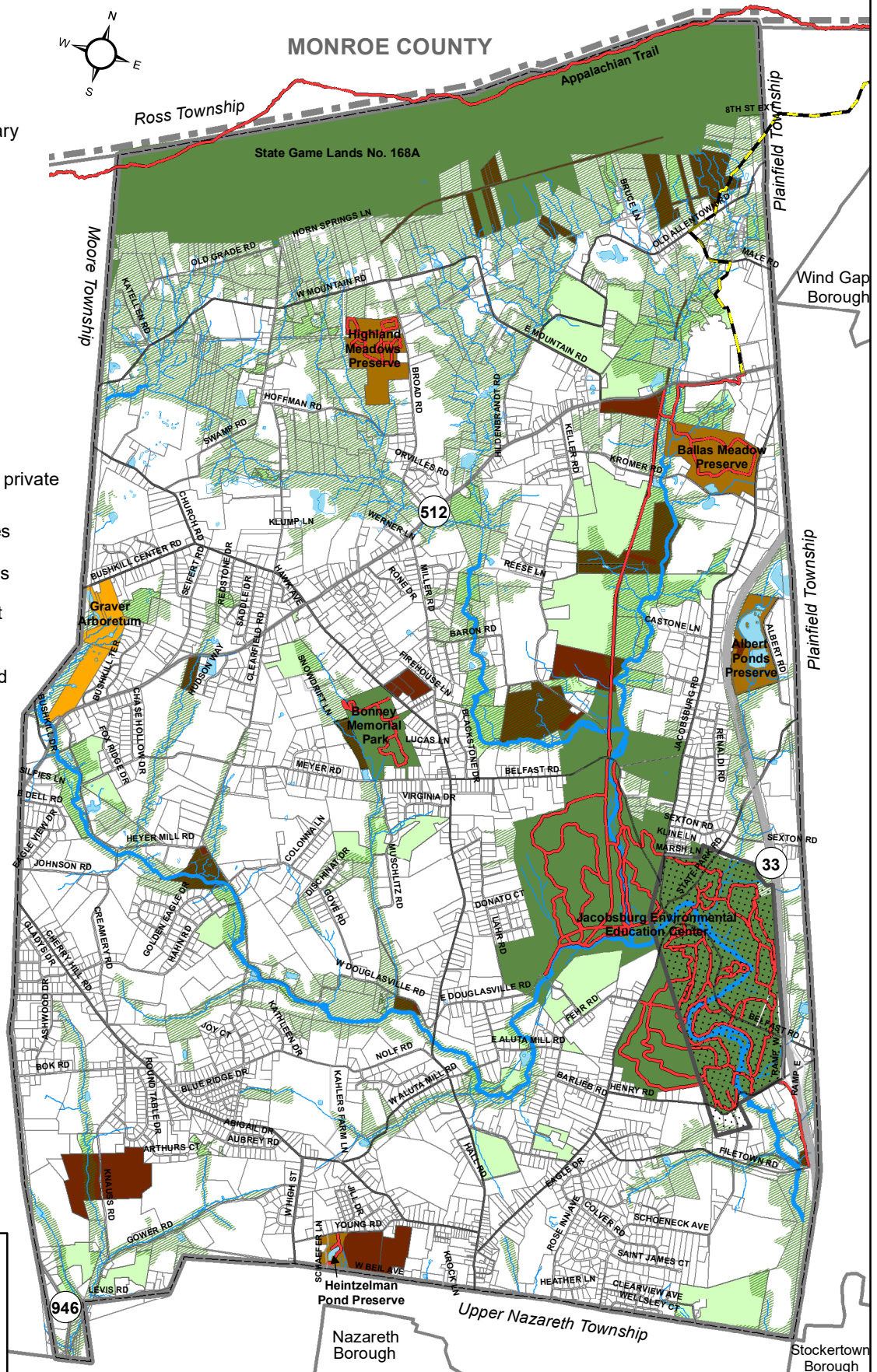
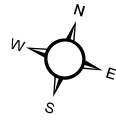
**Proposed Features**

Proposed greenways include the following:

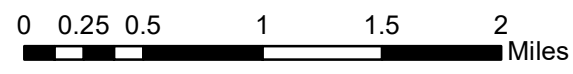
1 - Existing woodlands as shown on the "Woodlands" Geographic Information Systems layer found on the Lehigh and Northampton Counties Digital Geographic Data Disk Release 3.1, published by the Lehigh Valley Planning Commission in October 2004, except for those woodlands which are not connected to watercourses in any manner.

2 - A 150-foot buffer zone measured from the top bank of both sides of any stream which appears on U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle maps, resulting in a 300-foot minimum total buffer zone width.
